About our school

The British International School, Ukraine (BISU) is an inclusive international community which welcomes children aged 3-18 years old and promotes academic brilliance alongside sustainable progress beyond the classroom, passion for learning, creative thinking, social responsibility and global awareness, in a supportive atmosphere of care and trust.

We provide a quality holistic education which challenges our students to be broad-minded, observant, well-rounded, courageous and happy lifelong learners.

Our major task is to guide our students to feel valued, capable and to realise they play the role of creators in their own lives and futures. Through their vocation, they can give back to the world and make a difference.







We seek to empower young people to find their true calling in life through continuous learning, unleashed potential and personal growth.



Our priorities are the care and wellbeing of each child, provision of the highest standards of learning and teaching, service to the parents and support for the BISU community.

Why choose BISU?

Established in 1997, BISU was the first to bring a British-based world class education to Ukraine and is widely accepted as one of the country's most prestigious international schools.

Working according to the COBIS standards means that our students receive the same quality education as those studying in private schools in Great Britain.

More than 1,000 of our alumni continue their studies at the most prestigious institutions in different countries.

63% of BISU graduates entered universities in the UK, 46% of graduates were accepted to TOP-200 universities of the world, including Oxford, London School of Economics, King's College London, the University of Manchester, etc.

BISU assigns an academic mentor to each student who will support, coach, guide and motivate them to learn and pogress.

Learning is provided in small groups and includes an individual approach to each student. Teacher-to-student ratio is 1:5.

Bilingual education: we offer British (all subjects are taught by our qualified international teachers in English) and Ukrainian Curricula.

We help students complement their academic knowledge with the skills and attitudes essential for their future life in the 21st century in a global environment. These include: personal and social responsibility, creativity, critical thinking and decision-making.



Global connections and internationally renowned partners:

- BISU is a member of the Council of British International Schools (COBIS), which represents over 450 schools and organisations in 80 countries.
- We are the first international school in Europe and the second in the world to achieve the Gold EAL Quality Mark Award. It marks our achievements in meeting the needs of students learning English as an additional language.
- Our partners are reputable institutions with a rich history, including Cambridge Assessment dating back to 1858 and the International Baccalaureate founded in 1968.
- ♦ We are a Cambridge authorised exam centre, member of the Black Sea Schools Group – a loose grouping of COBIS schools in countries around the Black Sea Region (Azerbaijan, Bulgaria, Georgia, Romania, Moldova, Turkey and Ukraine). We participate in a variety of certified programmes: ASDAN, Edexcel, the Best Practice Network.

for the Academic year 2023-2024

Our well-balanced programme is based on a winning selection of British and Ukrainian Curricula, English language and enrichment activities to help your child get the most out of school.

BISU British Curriculum stems from the National Curriculum for England which is taught online and offline.

Ukrainian Curriculum operates according to the New Ukrainian School curriculum and the curricula recommended by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine. Taught online and offline.

Creative Enrichment Activities offered by BISU teachers and external providers ranging from Sustainability to Coding – is an optional but recommended part of the educational programme. Examples: Music, Drama, Art and Design, Physical Education etc.

The academic year runs from 1^{st} September until 30^{th} June and is divided into 3 terms:

- Autumn term (September December);
- Spring term (January March);
- ◆ Summer term (April June).

The languages of communication are English and Ukrainian. Children who have English as their second language have an opportunity to develop their language skills, improve social skills and follow the British curriculum.

We support children's physical, cognitive and emotional development. Forming healthy eating habits is part of our curriculum. Our chefs take a responsible approach to serve 3 balanced healthy meals to our children every day.

Well-being and safety of the children, families and staff has always been and will remain our top priority. BISU Kindegarten boasts a closed territory, round-the-clock security, video surveillance and a fully equipped, comfortable shelter.

International programme Years 7-9 Ukrainian programme Classes 6-8

BISU Advance Secondary is available for children aged 11 to 14 and includes Key Stage 3 of the British Curriculum (Years 7-9), the New Ukrainian School Curriculum (Class 6) and the curricula recommended by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine (Classes 7-8).

The programme starts as a smooth transition between primary and secondary school. The Curriculum is taught includes linguistic, literacy, aesthetic, geographical, scientific, historical, and physical areas of knowledge and experience.

By the end, students are expected to know, apply and understand the matters, skills and processes specified in the relevant programme of study.

Secondary immersive digital learning will be provided by BISU teachers in conjunction with selected internationally renowned partner organisations.

Key Stage 3 subjects include English, Mathematics and Science plus a selection of British National Curriculum subjects. Please see the full curriculum at www.gov.uk. o

International programme Years 10-11 Ukrainian programme Classes 9-10

BISU Advance Primary Secondary is available for children aged 14 to 16 and includes Key Stage 4 (Years 10-11) of the IGCSE/GCSE programme based on the British Curriculum (GCSE) but adapted for a more internationally-focused student body. The Ukrainian Curriculum is offered as Externat. At the end of the academic year, the 9 Class graduates receive Ukrainian State-Standard Certificates of incomplete general secondary education.

While studying the IGCSE/GCSE programme, your child will:

- Acquire, develop and apply a broad range of knowledge;
- Learn to think creatively and critically;
- Learn to respect themselves and others;
- Develop his/her physical skills;
- Recognise the importance of pursuing a healthy lifestyle.

Cambridge IGCSE

An IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education) is a qualification that is typically offered to students during their high school years, with the examinations for these taking place at the age of 16.

The qualification is recognised by many institutions in the world. It also allows further vocational education and is often considered the baseline for employment.



BISU students can complete their Cambridge IGCSEs and study the IBDP programme or A-level qualifications that will enable them to enter the top universities around the world.

International programme Years 12-13 Ukrainian programme Class 11

In Years 12 and 13 (Key Stage 5 or Sixth Form, 16-18 years old), your child chooses one of two preuniversity programmes: IBDP or A-levels. BISU has developed partnerships with a number of prestigious organisations around the world to be able to offer a wide range of subjects at both programmes.

These partnerships mean that we are empowered to create a bespoke programme of study for your child in order to ensure their interests are met, they have access to the subjects they require for further study at university and they are motivated to achieve their full potential.

After completing Key Stage 5, students will receive an IB diploma or A-level qualifications, which will allow them to apply to universities around the world. Upon successful completion of the Ukrainian Curriculum, 11 Class graduates receive Ukrainian State-Standard Certificates of complete secondary education.

Your child will:

- Develop confidence in their capacity to learn and work independently and collaboratively;
- Appreciate human aspirations and achievements in aesthetic, scientific, technological and social fields;
- Become creative, innovative, enterprising and capable of leadership.
- Become a responsible and caring citizen capable of contributing to the development of a just society;
- Respond positively to opportunities, challenges and responsibilities to manage risk and to cope with change and adversity.



Advance International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme

IBDP was developed by a group of international school educators back in 1960s and today there are more than 3000 schools offering the DP in 147 countries worldwide. The programme aims to develop students who have excellent breadth and depth of knowledge – students who flourish physically, intellectually, emotionally and ethically.

Through the IBDP, schools are able to develop students who:

- Have excellent breadth and depth of knowledge;
- Flourish physically, intellectually, emotionally and ethically;
- Study at least two languages;
- Excel in traditional academic subjects;
- Explore the nature of knowledge through the programme's unique theory of knowledge course.

IBDP alumni reported higher capacities for a variety of 21st-century skills compared to their non-DP counterparts





This 2-year programme takes a holistic approach to academic study with six subjects chosen in total.

The programme also has a core element that includes:

- Extended Essay (EE);
- Theory of Knowledge (TOK);
- Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS).



Advance A-levels

Advanced Level qualifications (known as A-levels) have a great reputation for being in-depth and rigorous, and they are very well recognised by universities and employers as a great qualification.

This 2-year programme comprises 3-4 specific subjects studied in greater depth alongside a Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) component.

There are no compulsory subjects at A-levels, so students are free to take the subjects that either interest them or are going to be beneficial to them in their future studies or careers.



What does it take to enroll for the A-level programme?

In general, students need to get 5 A* to Cs including English and Maths at IGCSE. In addition, students need a grade B or above in individual subjects that they wish to study to enable them to have the best opportunity to achieve the top grade at A-level.

What subjects do A-level students take at BISU?

By employing a combination of face-to-face teaching and blended learning, we ensure that our students have access to a wide range of subjects. Our current Sixth Form students are taking subjects, such as English Literature, Maths, Further Maths, Physics, Computer Science, Business Studies and Russian. There are a great other variety of subjects available to them. Two of our students are looking to apply to Oxford and Cambridge, which are ranked among the finest universities in the world.

Which exam boards do A-levels use?

Internationally, there are several exam boards which assess A-levels. Often, schools will use Edexcel or the Cambridge International Assessment. Here at BISU we use the Cambridge International Assessment for our A-level programme.

How do students decide if A-levels are right for them?

If a student enjoys academic learning and want to select from a broad range of subjects, then A-levels might be the right choice for them. If the student has got a passion or a strength within a subject, A-levels allow them to focus on their programme of study. A-levels have a great reputation for being in-depth and rigorous, and they are very well recognised by universities and employers as a great qualification.

So how do students make a choice between A-levels and the IB programme?

This is a difficult choice, and it depends on the individual student – on what they want to study and where they want to study it. Our dedicated Sixth Form team of teachers are British educated. They understand the issues, and they are always happy to help, support and guide our students.

Personal development, enterprise and leadership

To quote one of our key partners, ASDAN, they are "on a mission – to engage, elevate and empower young people". With this in mind, we have also set up a selection of complementary programmes alongside the academic programme to enhance our students' future prospects and develop their confidence.

Based on the Cambridge English Language suite of qualifications, our programme helps your child improve his/her English and increase their chances of success in other subjects.

British and International Curricula enable our students to focus on developing their English language proficiency through a range of subjects, themes and disciplines.


